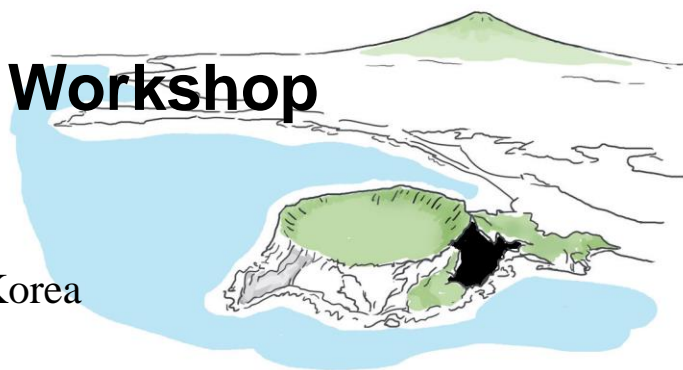


# 4<sup>th</sup> Asian Zirconium Workshop

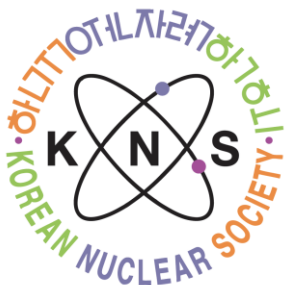

## Transportations



Jeju International Airport is conveniently located at the center of East Asia and is easily accessible from China, Japan, and Southeast Asia. The airport currently services 16 direct international flights and 13 domestic flights.
