

## Regional Training Course on Innovative Approaches for Nuclear Knowledge Management Using e-Learning through Learning Management System

The International Atomic Energy Agency and the Korea Atomic Energy Research Institute is organizing the above regional training course with the framework of TC project RAS/0/064-"Supporting Nuclear Education and Training through e-Learning and Other Means of Advanced Information Communication Technology (ICT)", to be held at KAERI, Daejeon, Republic of Korea, on 24 November - 28 November 2014.

NKM has become an increasingly important element of the nuclear sector in recent years, both for countries experienced in nuclear or for newcomers, for developed and for developing countries. Nuclear Knowledge should be managed to be transferred safely and thoroughly from the Centers of Competence to the Centers of Growth, taking into account not only the challenges posed by capacity building needs and the ageing of nuclear personnel, but also the relatively small number of students going into science and technology.

### The following topics are covered by this courses:

- › NKM fundamentals;
- › Developing policies and strategies for managing nuclear knowledge;
- › Managing nuclear information resources;
- › Human resources development and knowledge transfer;
- › Practical guidance and best practice on NKM;
- › Networking for knowledge sharing.

The training course includes traditional lectures combined with discussion periods, case studies and practical exercises in high interactive sessions. Renowned knowledge management specialists and experts from organizations with recognized NKM programmes will be provide the leading presentations and guide the students in their work and projects during the breakout sessions.

### PARTICIPATION:

- › The regional training courses is targeted at young professionals at the age between 30 to 40 years old
- › Participants from different organization in the nuclear sector who is in charge of managing nuclear knowledge in any form
- › The selection of participants will be made based on their qualification and experience related to the subject matter of the training course as well as the result of the online-training course on NKM using the regional Learning Management System(LMS)
- › The Agency will cover the cost of travel of the participants from their countries to Daejeon, Republic of Korea, and return. Moreover, the Agency will provide the participants with a Daily Subsistence Allowance(DSA) for the duration presented above.
- › The training course is open to approximately 32 participants from Asia and Pacific Region.
